Update on the release of the 5th edition of the ASX Corporate Governance Principles and Recommendations Consultation Draft

The ASX Corporate Governance Council (“Council”) develops and issues principles-based recommendations for corporate governance practices that are reported against annually by ASX listed entities.

The Council’s members have been actively working on the next edition of the Corporate Governance Principles and Recommendations. The consultation draft for the 5th edition is expected to be published in February 2024.

About the ASX Corporate Governance Council

The Council was convened by ASX Limited in August 2002 and is an independent body chaired by Elizabeth Johnstone. It brings together a range of different business, shareholder and industry groups designed to ensure that it reflects a diverse and representative range of views on the corporate governance practices to be adopted by ASX listed entities.
