What you will be doing:

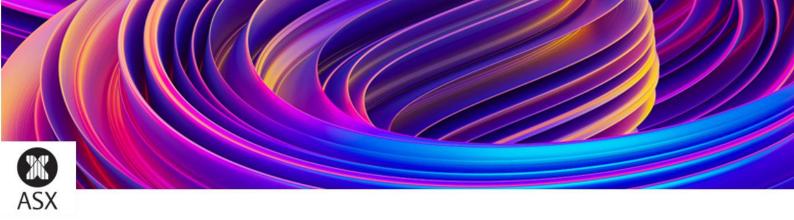
- You are a practitioner/team member of the Quality Engineering & Testing Capability Community of Practice (CoP).
