What you will be doing:

• Responsible for managing and updating Project Risk Management Framework by ensuring it is fit for purpose and aligned to industry standards – review, mature, embed and continuously evolve and improve; enabling quality outcomes



- Contribution to the continuous improvement of the ASX Delivery Framework and associated tooling
- Work closely with the Enterprise Risk Management function (Line 2) to ensure clear accountabilities are in place and that the Project Risk Management practices align to and integrate with wider Enterprise Risk Management policies and practices.
- Strengthen the Project Risk Management Capability across the Lines of Business including developing and implementing project risk framework and assurance education programs that promote, champion and embed continuous improvement and adoption of best practice risk management as it applies to ASX's project delivery portfolio
- Provide advisory and coaching services to major projects and programs with regards to quality Project Risk Management setup, challenging risk and supporting risk management practice
- Develop, maintain and reporting on key performance metrics in the portfolio level governance forums
- Assess and report on key risk indicators at project and portfolio level and independently monitor and report on these to executive level governance forums up to Board level
- Facilitate the Enterprise Delivery Group Enterprise Risk Profiling cycle and support operation within enterprise risk appetite for greater effectiveness across project disciplines.

- Extensive experience in applying project risk management techniques, including planning for, controlling and reviewing risks and uncertainty, in complex projects a deep understanding of project 'delivery' risk, and 'risk in change' is required
- Demonstrated experience in project risk management, COBIT, ISO 31000 and/or IEC 62198, in development and implementation of project risk management frameworks and associated best practice processes, ideally within financial services, other critical infrastructure sector or evolving technology environment
- Experience with a variety of project methodologies and frameworks including Agile, Lean and traditional methods
- Ability to convert data into information and insight to provide accurate executive and portfolio reporting and continuous improvements
