- Undertake project start-up and closure administrative activities, including the creation of Jira Projects, Confluence Sites and project codes.
- Monitor EPMO SNAP Service Request dashboard and respond to queries.
- Facilitate and build strong relationships with Line of Business Portfolio's to provide PPM guidance and support to enable embedment of changes, including processes, documentation and tooling

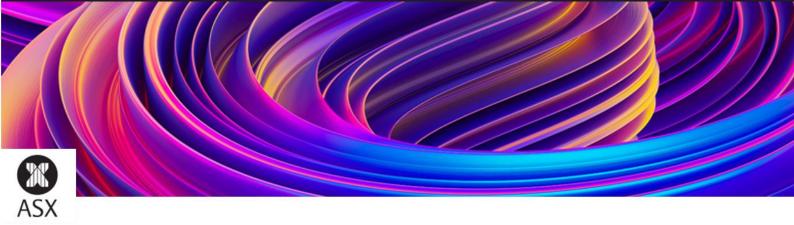
What you will bring:
