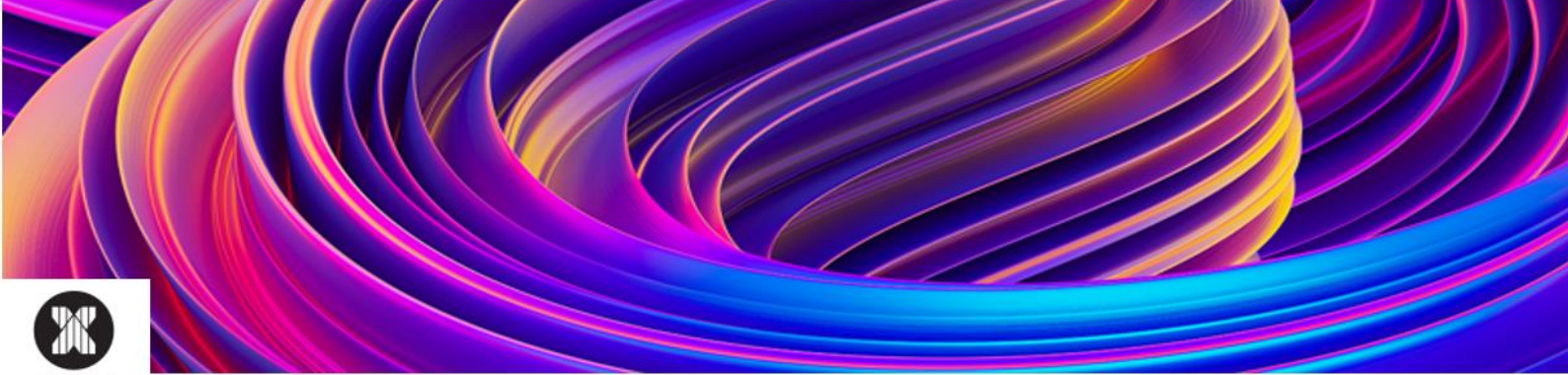
About the team:

What you will be doing:

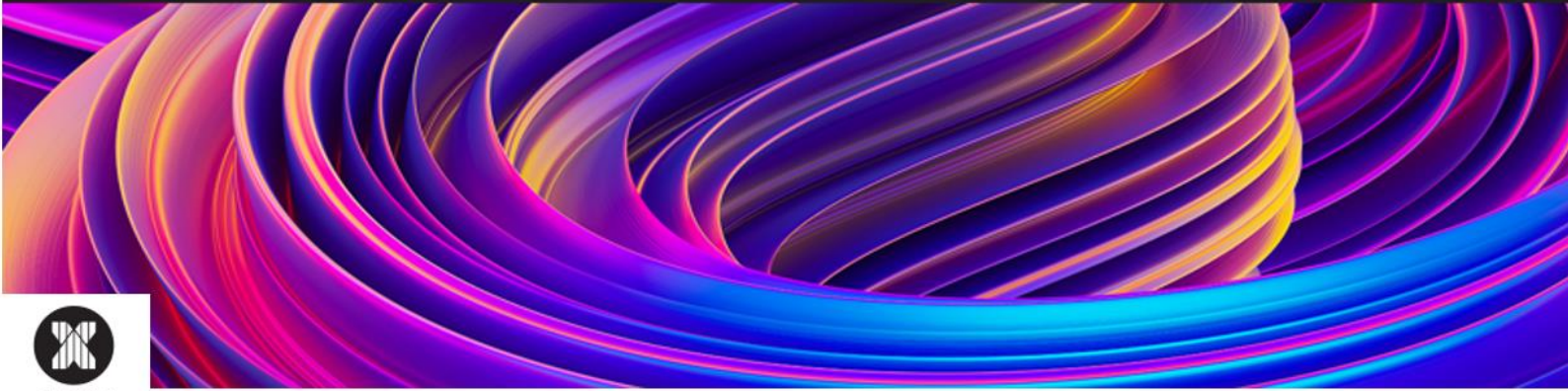
- You are a practitioner/team member of the Quality Engineering and Testing Capability Community of Practice (CoP).
- Reviewing requirements and specifications and independently creating test cases based on these, mapping back to pre-determined criteria.



- Design, code, verify, amend and refactor test automation code and scripts. Ensure traceability records exist from tests back to requirements.
- Assist the ServiceNow engineering team in test planning and specifying requirements for test environments, test data and tools. Contribute to the selection of the test automation approach for projects.
- Apply agreed standards and tools, to achieve well-engineered outcomes.
- Collaborate in reviews of own work and lead reviews of colleagues' work.
- Responsible for interpreting and executing test scripts, analysing results and maintaining a defect register.
- Provide reports on progress, anomalies, risks & issues associated with assigned tasks.
- Support and implement the ASX Software Testing Policy and Guidelines within the context of the assigned work and tools used, and create and maintain documentation relevant to this.
