Assess risks and take preventative action. Identify improvements and contribute to the development of organisational policies, standards, and guidelines for testing.

What you will be doing:

Overall:

• Development and execution of quality test automation activities including approach, planning, test design and test cases for Customer and Digital BAU and Projects.



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- Mentor and develop junior team members and contribute to team continuous improvement
- Assist with Centre Of Excellence and Testing Community of Practice policy rollouts and implementation as required

Testing:

- Assist with planning, and execution of testing activities across all stages and iterations of product, systems and service development. Including selecting appropriate testing approach of manual or automated testing.
- Implement scalable and reliable automated tests and frameworks in consultation with the Automation Test Lead
- Collaborates across parties involved in product, systems or service design and development to enable comprehensive test coverage
- Analyses and reports on test activities, results, issues and risks, including the work of others.
- Assess risks and take preventative action.
- Identify improvements and contributes to the development of organisational policies, standards, and guidelines for testing.

Software development and Programming:

- Design, code, verify, tests, document, amend and refactor complex programs/scripts and integration software services.
- Contribute to the selection of the software development methods, tools and techniques.
- Apply agreed standards and tools to achieve well-engineered outcomes.
- Participate in reviews of own work and lead reviews of colleagues' work.

Methods and Tools:

- Experience in establishing and expanding test Automation frameworks and test automation case coverage




- Experience with API tools like Swagger, Postman
