



Project update

Recent achievements and project milestones

- > Consultation period on proposed changes to netting and settlement workflow closed on 18 March 2021
 - > Focus groups sessions were held with software providers, clearing and settlement participants and settlement only participants & the ISO 20022 Technical Committee was reconvened
- > Additional test tools and two new demand reports introduced as part of the CDE uplift
- > Messaging accreditation requirements are largely complete for the Day 1 original scope
- > Development and testing work for the CHESS UI is continuing to track to plan
- > ASX's Registration Details Tool to be released to software providers
- > Series of clearing and settlement pricing discussions with a broad range of participants
- > Information paper for listed entities and issuers of exchange traded securities about potential changes
- > DLT Solutions launches ASX App Cloud using DAML http://asx.projectdabl.com/



Registration Details Tool




Registration Details Tool

- > All accounts (HINs) will be migrated from CHESS to CHESS Replacement during cut-over weekend
- > CHESS EIS formatted registration details will be migrated from their current CHESS EIS format to ISO 20022 format
- > Post go-live sponsoring participant who amend existing accounts (HINs) will be required to supply updated details in ISO 20022 format as well as supplying a new 'Holder ID' which for existing accounts can be derived
- > Sponsoring participants and issuers may wish to reflect the change to this new format in their own host systems, but not required
- > A number of options are available to achieve this;
 - > Applying the mapping published on the ASX documentation website
 - > Use of the Registration Details Tool
 - Post go-live using the Ledger API



Accessing the tool

Purpose of the tool:

- > To convert account registration details from the legacy to format aligned to ISO 20022 messaging standard
- > To identify accounts with registration details that are not aligned to ISO 20022 messaging standard and/or business rules in CHESS Replacement

Who can apply for the tool:



Data Remediation

Cleaning up current CHESS registration details

> HIN registration details

- Details in current CHESS must align with ISO 20022 messaging standards & business rules in CHESS replacement
- > Exceptions have been identified for HIN registrations that do not comply
- > Remediation of the relevant fields and formats is needed to ensure a successful migration

Example of exceptions: Holder name is longer than 80 characters

Address Line 1 missing registration details

Invalid Country


> Communicating exceptions (from April 2021)

- > Direct contact will be made with each Participant who has HIN registration exceptions
- > ASX will share reported exceptions and remediation required in CHESS production
- > ASX and the Participant will agree steps to remediate known exceptions and address potential for future exceptions
- > Use of the tool to support data cleansing activity is not mandatory
